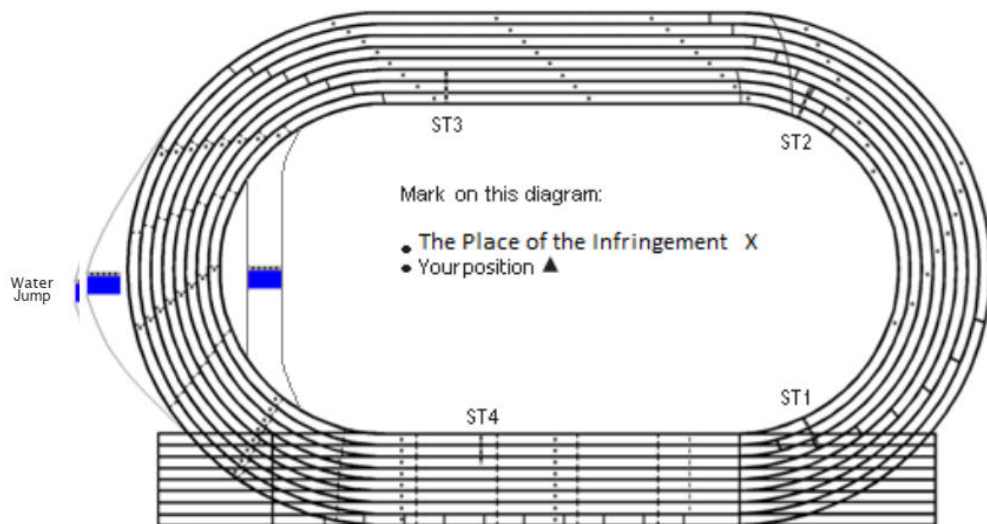

7.9	Athlete and Guide not attached by a tether throughout the race
7.10	Athlete pushed / pulled / otherwise propelled by guide in order to gain advantage
19.4	Athlete not in front of Guide when reaching finish line
23.8 (e)	Visually Impaired assistant did not follow instructions of officials at change
Wheelchair (T32 – 34 & T51 – 54)	
6.7	Athlete failed to display number/name on back of chair or side of race running frame
6.9	Athlete failed to display number on helmet when required by LOC
6.22	No helmet worn by athlete
8.5	Athlete allowed urine to drain onto track
14.6	Part of lower limb fell to ground during event (not applicable to T32 competitors)
18.3	Means other than pushing on the wheels or push rims used to propel chair
18.4	Overtaking athlete cut in before achieving full clearance of chair being overtaken
23.6	Received assistance by pushing or other method during takeover
23.19	4 x 200m / 4 x 400m: Athlete took position other than in the two lanes allocated
Prostheses (T45 – 47 and T61 – 64)	
6.12	T61-64 Athlete did not complete race with lower limb prosthetic attached
6.14	T45-47 Athlete competed with upper limb prosthetic but did not complete race with device
Assistance to Athletes	
Received assistance or coaching. Give details opposite	
Athlete Misconduct	
Athlete acting in an unsporting or improper manner. Give details opposite or on back of form.
