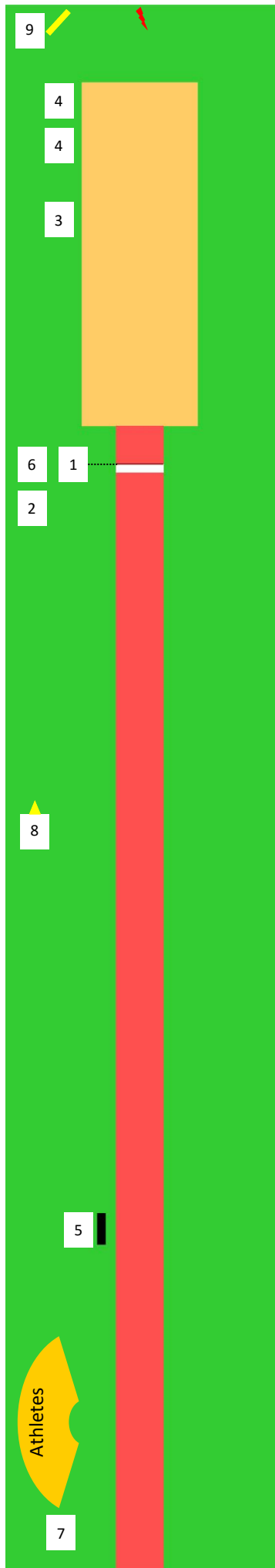


Long Jump - Team of Officials



- 1 Chief Judge - Supervise entire event, check jump has been made correctly, check & call all measurements, indicate valid jump (white flag) or failure (red flag).
- 2 Recorder Judge - Keeping the results sheet.
- 3 Landing Measure Judge - Holding measuring apparatus (tape) on the zero mark on the impact point closest to take-off board.
- 4 Landing Zone Judge/s - In charge of levelling the landing zone after each trial.
- 5 Wind Gauge Judge - In charge of the wind gauge who must operate from a point 20m from the take off board, call athletes on behalf of the Recorder Judge.
- 6 Plasticine Judge - In charge of replacing the plasticine on the take-off board.
- 7 Athlete Control Judge - In charge of athletes, supervising interactions, movements etc
- 8 Time Judge - In charge of indicating to athletes / Chief Judge that they have a certain time to take their trial.
- 9 Indicator Board (often volunteer) - In charge of the indicator board for spectators.

This is a traditional setting up of the team of officials.
Due to availability of officials differs, the above is in order of requirements.
