



- 1 Chief Judge - Supervise entire event, check jump has been made correctly, check & call all measurements, indicate valid jump (white flag) or failure (red flag).
- 2 Bar Judge - In charge of moving the uprights to the athletes requirements, replacing the bar after each failed trial and assisting with increasing the height of the bar.
- 3 Recorder Judge - Calling the athletes & keeping the results sheet.
- 4 Athlete Control Judge - In charge of athletes, supervising interactions, movements etc
- 5 Time Judge - In charge of indicating to athletes / Chief Judge that they have a certain time to take their trial.
- 6 Indicator Board (often volunteer) - In charge of the indicator board for spectators.

This is a traditional setting up of the team of officials.
Due to availability of officials differs, the above is in order of requirements.
