Practical Proficiency Requirements

Level A

Group 1, 2, 3, 4 & 6

- Officiate at least **15** competition days at Senior Centre level or above, in **all** event group elements.
- Including at least 2 competition days at Regional Champs or above.

Group 5

- Officiate at least 10 competition days at Senior Centre level or above.
- Including at least 1 competition day at Regional Champs or above.

In addition to the Practical component Officials **MUST** attend **2 (two)**, (one which must be on the event group) education seminars. These are to be entered on the card and signed by the lecturer.

Level B

Group 1, 2, 3, 4 & 6

- Officiate at least 10 competition days at Senior level or above
- Including at least 1 competition day at Regional Champs or above.

Group 5

- Officiate at least 6 competition days at Senior level.
- Including at least 1 competition day at Regional Champs or above

In addition to the Practical component Officials **MUST** attend **1 (one)** education seminar. This is to be entered on the card and signed by the lecturer.

NOTE: Club nights/days cannot be counted as competition days to fulfilling the Practical Experience requirements.

NOTE: A competition day means one day of competition

Once you have completed your Practical Experience Card and its been checked by the ROE that all required practical components completed and education seminars attended, then an exam may be attempted.

Event Groups

1. Jumps: long/triple jump; high jump; pole vault.

Event chief, spiking, wind gauge, recording, board/bar judge, time clock, setup

2. Throws: discus; hammer; javelin; shot put.

Event chief, circle judge, fall judge, recording, EDM, time clock, equipment set up

3. Track: judging; wind gauge; umpire; start team; timing; photo finish, call room (A Grade).

4. Walks: judging: event chief; DQ board; recording.

5. Outside Events: starts; umpire; judging; recording; timekeeping; course setup

6. Administration: recording; seeds; draws; meet manager; competition management; announcing.

7. Course Measuring*: calibration; measure; record/report.

8. Para*: all aspects of track; throws and jumps events as related to Para competition.
